To the Applicant:

Mt Mansfield Masonic Lodge, located in Jericho, Vermont annually awards scholarships in the amount of \$500 to high school seniors to assist them in continuing their educational endeavors at an accredited two- or four-year college, or accredited trade school. Scholarships may be used for any bona fide school expense such as tuition, fees, and books. In 2010, three scholarships will be awarded, one to each of the three high schools in the communities that the Lodge serves.

This scholarship is open to all students completing their senior year at Lamoille Union High School, Mt Mansfield Union High School, and Winooski High School. It is also open to home schooled students residing within the boundaries of the three school districts. The application must be submitted to your school's Guidance Office (or other designated recipient) no later than April 30th of your year of graduation. Applicants need not have Masonic affiliation nor are they restricted by race, creed, color, sex, handicap, or national origin. All students are highly encouraged to apply.

Since the members of the Scholarship Selection Committee have not met you and will only have this application by which to judge you, consider carefully the content and completeness of your responses to the information being sought. A broad-based criterion is used in the selection process, including an applicant's academic standing, communication skills, financial need, community service, and leadership. The organization, appearance, and completeness of your application are also factors considered by the selection committee.

You may complete this application in pen, typewriter, or computer. A copy of the application can also be downloaded from the Mt Mansfield Lodge website. Please ensure that your handwriting is legible.
